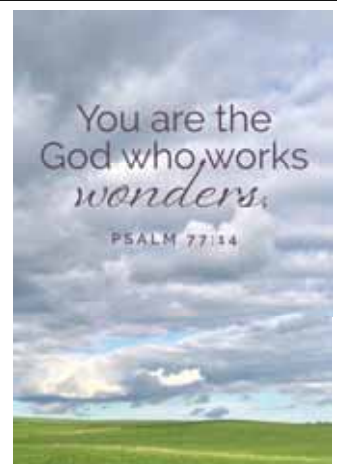

Millions of families lack a nearby supply of fresh, safe water. For us, we simply turn on a faucet. For them, tremendous time and effort is required every single day to meet this basic survival need. Malnutrition, sickness, and shortened life expectancy are common in these areas.

February 11-18, 2017 Mulberry will send a team to drill a well and teach hygiene for a community in Guatemala. This will be Mulberry's 6<sup>th</sup> Living Water International water well installation! Men and women are needed to help out on the drill team, and women are needed to help out with hygiene instruction and arts & crafts. Youth are welcome with adult accompaniment.

Our team is forming now, and we need your help! This will be an incredible experience for all involved. The cost is \$650 plus a nonrefundable \$30 online LWI background check. This price includes all transportation, room, and board.
