MLK Jr. Weekend January 13th-16th 2017

Consider this is your invitation to Mulberry's intergenerational mission trip involving confirmands, youth, young adults, adults, and senior adults *"Generation to Generation"...* all working together to be the church in love and mission together in the beauty of the Blue Ridge Mountains. A concerted effort is being made to make this truly a Generation to Generation work trip from ages 12 to 102. This promises to be a fun, meaningful, and enlightening experience for everyone! A holiday/mission weekend you won't want to miss!

Destination: Hinton Rural Life Center (www.HintonCenter.org), a Methodist retreat center in Hayesville, NC (about four hours away).

Departure: from the church parking lot Friday, January 13th at 1pm

Return: Monday January 16th no later than 3pm.

Work: various projects organized by the Hinton Center such as flooring, painting, sheet rock, firewood distribution and supply, and other unknown work to us at this time as well as non-construction service projects varying to work skills, abilities, and opportunities for the weekend of work, instruction, and fellowship. More specifics will be known after commitments are made and surveys are completed for Hinton's mission team coordinators.

Rooms: Dorm room suites with private baths. Bunk style beds with 1 queen size. 3 rooms are handicap accessible. See more at www.HintonCenter.org

Cost: Total cost is \$195 and includes all but two travel meals to and from Hinton Friday and Monday. A \$100 deposit due by November 6th along with all paper work completed.

Tools: Provided by Hinton Rural Life Center

\$100 Checks should be made out to Mulberry St. UMC (memo: G2G mission trip) and brought to the church office with completed paper work (available in the church office) including 1) the application for mission, 2) a *notarized* liability release form, and 3) a Safe Sanctuary background check 4) a chaperone and volunteer covenant and 5) the papers required by Hinton (two pages in the back plus the skill sheet) ***no later than November 6th*** to reserve your spot on the roster. The remaining balance of \$95 will be due by Wednesday December 16th after which all money will be non-refundable. For scholarships, please contact your generation's coordinator listed below.
